Hitting the Target: A Change of Focus in Health Research 15 & 16 March 2012, Q1 Resort & Spa, Gold Coast

The Australasian Health and Research Data Manager's Association 21st Annual Scientific Meeting (ASM) will be held at the glorious Q1 Resort & Spa on the Gold Coast on the 15th and 16th of March 2012.

With the theme of "Hitting the Target: A Change of Focus in Health Research," the conference will include a wide range of topics from national and local speakers, in addition to showcasing the advances, breakthroughs and expertise in health and clinical research that Queensland is providing locally, nationally and globally.

Day 1 of the conference will include invited speakers and proffered papers highlighting the advances and innovation associated with the targeted treatment of disease, individualised health care solutions and the revision of traditional treatment modalities. The day will include a choice from two workshops catering to the diversity of the AHRDMA membership: a practical tool-building exercise in professional development from well-respected educators, or a panel-driven participatory session examining and improving work design.

On day 2, the conference will shift focus to the non-patient driven aspects of our work such as the expected impact of the personally controlled electronic health record (PCEHR) on clinical research and the ongoing changes in the regulatory environment. The day will include updates from experts in e-health and the roll-out of the multi-centre ethical review process affecting most of Australia.

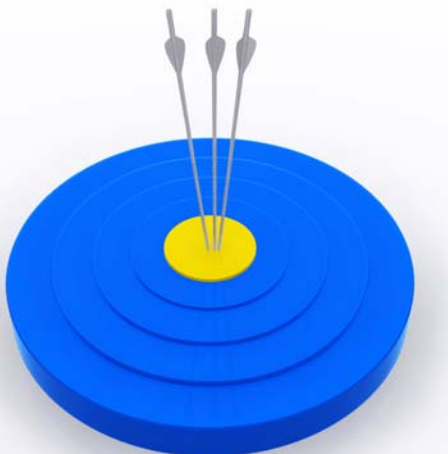
